

# PROMOTIONAL/OPEN ENTRANCE ANNOUNCEMENT

## WATER DISTRIBUTION & WASTEWATER COLLECTION SUPERVISOR

### NATURE OF WORK:

This position oversees and supervises the work of several crews engaged in the location, maintenance and repair of water and wastewater pipelines, valves, meters, fire hydrants, manholes, lift stations, and related installations. Work may require extensive customer contact. This person is responsible for the supervision of foremen and crews at diverse locations. Work is performed with considerable independence with review by the Public Works Director.

### DESIRABLE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Graduation from high school with extensive experience in insulations, maintenance, and repair of water distribution and wastewater collection systems including lift stations; or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Must have functional telephone in his residence for on call duty. Possession of Class III or IV Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection certification as issued by the State of Louisiana.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### WHO MAY APPLY:

This position is open to all registered voters living within a twelve miles radius of the City of Opelousas who meet the minimum qualifications for the position. Applicants whose qualifications are acceptable shall be notified the particulars for the examination.

### HOW TO APPLY:

Applications must be received from the Civil Service Office, Municipal Plaza, 105 North Main Street, Opelousas, LA 70570. All questions on said application must be answered, failure to do so may result in applicant receiving a lower score, or rejection of the application. All applications must be signed, mailed, or delivered to the Civil Service Director at her office in Municipal Hall. Applications must be received in the Civil Service Office not later than twelve o'clock noon, Tuesday, October 2, 2018.

### MILITARY PREFERENCE:

Three (5) points shall be added to the grade on Open Entrance examination for all applicants with military service under honorable conditions provided that the points may be added only after a passing score is attained. Three (3) points shall be added to the grade on Promotional examination for all applicants with military service under honorable conditions provided that the points may be added only after a passing score. Applicants claiming preference under the provisions of this rule must present discharge papers to the Civil Service Director for determination of eligibility under the Louisiana Constitution.
